# SUBMITTING YOUR PROPOSAL

Completing the online <u>Session Proposal Form</u> is easy! Please have the following information ready before you submit:

- current contact information for submitter and each presenter/panelist
- session title
- session description (75 words or less)
- current PCACAC membership status for all presenters/panelists
- a brief biographical sketch of each presenter/panelist (50 words or less), to include educational background (needed to determine eligibility of CEU credits through NACAC).

Organizations wishing to present a conference session must have at least one **PCACAC member from a secondary school** or college as a co-presenter.

#### IF SELECTED

The Sessions Committee will balance program sessions based on the needs of attendees. If selected, presenters/panelists are expected to:

- register for the Conference by the registration deadline.
- submit session presentations in PowerPoint or PDF format to the Conference Planning Committee Chair no later than April 1, 2017 (send to: <u>info@pcacac.org</u>).
