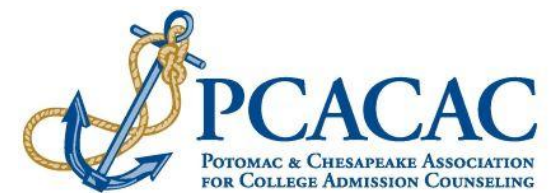

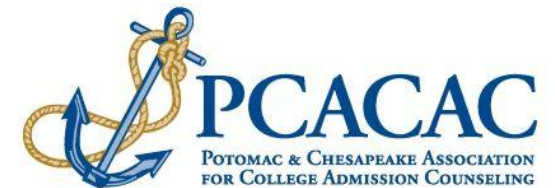

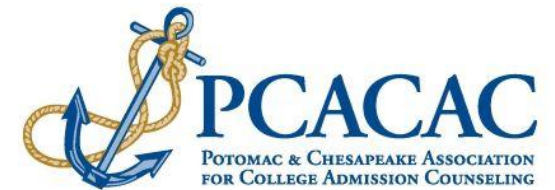
Leadership Challenges
