## **Registration & Lodging Fees**

Summer Institute registration includes sessions, meals, a campus tour, lodging (except Sunday) and free parking (parking is limited and carpooling is encouraged). If you are staying for the college tours, lodging for Monday and Tuesdays night is included in that registration fee.

#### Please note:

- If you choose to arrive on Sunday night, dinner is on your own.
- College Tours are an optional part of the Summer Institute <u>and cannot be booked as a stand-alone event</u>. One of the college tours along with dinner will take place Tuesday evening. The other two will be on Wednesday.
- One-day registration is not available.

- 1. Create a "dummy" email address for <u>each</u> individual (i.e., info1@pcacac.org, info2@pcacac.org, etc.) to access the registration form.
- 2. Be sure to write down the email address you used and the password assigned by the registration system (a combination of numbers and letters). You will not receive this information in the confirmation email.
- 3. Complete the registration form for each individual and insert TBD in the required name fields.
- 4. Provide your name and email address in the "ADDITIONAL CONTACT INFORMATION" section of the form and we will email you a copy of the registration.
- 5. When you know who the individual(s) is/are, you may use the email(s) as the username and the password(s) assigned to log back into the submitted form (as an Existing User) and update their information.

#### **PAYMENT POLICY**

All registration fees must be paid in full by the start of the Summer Institute. *Please remember, we do not offer on-site registration*. Payment may be made during the online registration process either by credit card or by selecting the "Send Check" option. **NOTE:** If selecting the "Send Check" option, your check must be received by **July 7, 2017.** For either payment method, once registration has been completed an Invoice/Receipt will be sent immediately to the registrant at the email address provided.
