Non-Binding

Students can apply to multiple institutions

Rolling **Admissions**

- Students can apply at any time
- Seats may fill up early



Reviewing an Application: The Basics

Approach can and, most likely, will vary by institution

- Review by major/school/program/region/other
- May have limited or competitive admission programs
- May have 1-4 reviewers and/or a committee structure
- May request additional information of an applicant after the initial review

Decision Types

- Admit
- Conditional/Provisional Admit
- Defer
- Waitlist
- Deny


Quantitative Review vs. Qualitative Review

• Where do you start...Read essay and recs first? Go straight to the transcript/scores?









Other Components

Extracurricular Activities

Not the what...it is about the why Depth vs. breadth Quality over quantity Essays

A chance to hear the student's unique voice

What does a student what us to know about them? School Specific Essays / Supplements

Gauge alignment for a particular school/program See where the student sees

themselves





The Role of Context

Family Background & make-up

• 1st gen, only child, step-parents, divorced, single parent, etc.

Geographical

• City, rural, suburban, international

Adversity

- Hardships, loss of family/friends, natural disaster, mental health
- Evidence of perseverance/persistence

Characteristics

• Maturity, independence, responsibility

School academic rigor/culture/opportunities

• School profile, letters of recommendation, college going culture/percentages
